**“GOVERNMENT GONE WILD”
SEMINAR PLANNED AT
CONSERVATIVE CLUB**

Blaise Ingoglia, a Spring Hill Builder and Chairman of the Hernando County Republican Executive Committee, spoke at the Conservative Club of East Pasco regarding bringing to east Pasco a Government Gone Wild seminar. Mr. Ingoglia began the series in 2007, targeting sharp rises in county property taxes and in 2010 the seminar targeted the federal government with satire and crowd interaction. Two previous seminars in Brooksville and Spring Hill attracted hundreds of people. He told the members no campaign literature or political signs whatsoever are allowed at his seminars and that he intends to present “jaw dropping” numbers of what tax rates would have to be now to close the deficit. The seminar is intended to motivate and inform the electorate to become better stewards of tax dollars.

At the meeting the membership agreed to plan “together meetings” in east Pasco including all interested conservatives meeting to engage in discussions and debate current events. Another leaders roundtable would include conservatives, tea party and 9/12 members sharing ideas and combining efforts. A third idea is for a roundtable of community leaders to develop strategies to address community concerns. Dick Albrecht, club president, lead the group in a pledge to support and defend the Constitution of the United States.
